### Nonfiction Conventions

#### How to Play:

Pass out a card to each student. Double up or have students share depending on number. The "starter" card begins by reading their card. Students solve the problems to figure out if they have the next card. The next student stands up and says, "I have\_\_\_. Who has\_\_?". The game continues until the last card is read.
